



## Mr. Dan JonesChief Engineer at Torotrak Group

Dan Jones is a mechanical engineer and is currently Chief Engineer at Torotrak. An alumni of the University of Hertfordshire, Mr. Jones graduated in 2006 receiving a BSc (Hons) degree in Motorsport Technology. His course included a placement year at Nissan's European Technical Centre in Cranfield and he also led the university's Formula Student team to a 5<sup>th</sup> place overall finish in the 2006 competition.

Mr. Jones' career began with a nine month stint working for Bentley Motors as a Suspension Design Engineer. In June 2007 he left to join Flybrid as a Design Engineer, working on the design and development of high-speed flywheel based mechanical hybrid systems for applications in motorsport, mainstream automotive, commercial vehicle and off-highway sectors.

Following promotion to Chief Designer at Flybrid in 2011 the company was acquired by Torotrak PLC in January 2014. Mr. Jones became Chief Designer for the group and joined the Senior Management Team, following a recent restructuring of the Torotrak Group his role has now changed to Chief Engineer with responsibility for all technical aspects of program delivery.

Mr. Jones has remained involved with Formula Student since graduating, he is currently Chief Technical Scrutineer for the UK event, Vice-Chairman of the FSAE Rules Committee and was a contributing author to the Race Tech book "Learn & Compete".
