You can study part time up to 45 credits per semester, (normal study rate is 30 credits per semester) but please take note of which modules run in each semester. Remember, you must do the two **compulsory modules** (45 credits in total) plus 75 credits in the **optional modules/short course** (120 credits in total) in order to gain your BSc (Hons) Contemporary Nursing Degree. It is recommended that you complete the research module early in your programme as this module will equip you with literature searching skills that you will require for all modules. You may bring up to a maximum of 30 credits in from another programme or university, but this will need to be discussed with the programme tutor, so if you have some credits already with another university, write them down first. Alternatively, you can study up to 30 credits from our range of 'short courses'. Click here for the link to these.

If you are working in an intensive or emergency care setting, then you must complete the Assessment - Physiology Based module (6HSK0059) prior to commencing the Emergency Care or Intensive Care modules. You must complete the Assessment - Advanced History Taking and Top-to-Toe Examination (6HSK0070) prior to commencing the Minor Illness – Autonomous Practice and/or the Minor Injury- Autonomous Practice. The Research for Nursing Practice module (6HSK0074) and the Leadership Skills (6HSK0068) both run on the same day in Semester A with research in the morning and leadership in the afternoon, so these are two good modules to do together.

Dates given are subject to change, so please contact the module leader directly for further information relating to final dates, times, course content and assessment.

You do not need to submit this form, however, you can bring with you if you meet with me as the Programme Leader. Please make an appointment at least once per semester with me to discuss your ongoing development and credit accumulation.
