



### Dr Shori Thakur

Shori Thakur studied Pharmacology at the University of Hertfordshire between 1996 and 2000 and subsequently went on to complete a PhD in Molecular Pharmacology, investigating the transcriptional regulation of cationic amino acid transporters in cultured vascular smooth muscle cells. This was followed by a 3 year GlaxoSmithKline-funded postdoctoral fellowship that focused her research on identifying transport mechanisms that mediate entry of highly selective inhibitors of the inducible nitric oxide synthase enzyme into cells.

She took up her position as a Senior Lecturer in Pharmacology in 2007 and has continued her research on nitric oxide, successfully supervising PhD and Masters students. She currently leads a team of nine researchers studying for PhDs or Masters Degrees. She is also the Research Tutor and Research Degrees Admissions Tutor for the Department of Human and Environmental Sciences and contributes to teaching and other administrative duties.
