- Aim: Co-create a proposal for the how and what of an online academic skills hub



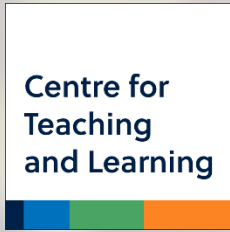
We aim to design internship projects that lead to the co-creation of outputs that can **act as inputs** for a range of evolving projects.
