Module Delivery

Generally, modules are usually delivered via:

- On campus sessions
 - ✓ Lectures: Lectures generally consists of a presentation of the weekly topic.
 - ✓ Seminars/tutorials: In tutorials students are split into smaller groups, session are more interactive, the topic presented during the lecture is further explored.
- Asynchronous material (e.g. Power point presentations/Recorded/video presentations etc)

Placements

- Support for placement search (e.g. workplace module, careers and placement support etc)
- The school is going to support you in your attempt to secure a placement, but it is ultimately your responsibility to find a suitable placement.
- Note: In order to be eligible to apply for placements you need to pass your semester A modules.



How to fund your postgraduate study - PG Loan

The UK Government provides postgraduate loans of up to £12,167 .


If you took out a Master's Loan, you'll only repay when your income is over £403 a week, £1,750 a month or £21,000 a year.

Loan eligibility requirements:

- Applicants are under 60 years old
- Are a UK national and have lived in the UK for three years before studying
- EU national residing in England with settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme and have been ordinarily resident in the EEA or Switzerland for three years
- Will be studying a full-time course lasting one or two years or studying a part-time course that is no longer than twice the length of the full-time equivalent course
- Applicants should not already have a Master's or equivalent qualification
