From September 2016, there is an additional compulsory module and students may opt to follow the PgDip or PgCert route from the outset.

All students can study part time up to 45 credits per semester, (*normal study rate is 30 credits per semester*) but please take note of which modules run in each semester. Remember, you must do the **compulsory modules** plus the number of credits achieved by taking **optional modules** that get you to the appropriate number of credits for the award you are studying.

- For the MSc Contemporary Nursing you must achieve 180 credits including at least 150 at level 7.
- For the PgDip Contemporary Nursing you must achieve 120 credits, including at least 90 at level 7
- For the PgCert Contemporary Nursing you must achieve 60 credits at level 7

For students who registered on PgCert Contemporary Nursing - Any 60 credits from the level 7 Contemporary Nursing Modules is required.

It is suggested that you complete the compulsory module Advanced Decision Making for Health and Social Care early in your pathway as this module will equip you with the level 7 academic skills that you will require for all modules. This module runs in semester B and C. In semester C the module is flexible and the teaching condensed so as not to fill the whole of the summer period. If you are planning to begin your programme with a clinical module in semester A (September), I recommend taking Advanced Decision Making for Health and Social Care first in the preceding Semester C (June/July).

You may bring up to a maximum of 30 credits in from another programme or university, but this will need to be discussed with the programme tutor (or Advanced Practice Pathway Lead where appropriate), so if you have some credits already with another university include them on your plans. Alternatively, you may study up to 30 credits from our range of 'short courses'. [Click here](#) for the link to these.

You need to complete the Assessment - Physiology Based module prior to commencing the Emergency Care or Intensive Care modules, and we recommended that you complete the Assessment – Advanced History Taking and Top to Toe Examination prior to commencing the Minor Illness – Autonomous Practice and/or the Minor Injury- Autonomous Practice.

You do not have to submit this form, however, you are strongly advised to make an appointment with the Programme Leader to discuss and formulate a study plan for the duration of your programme. You will need to fill in an application form and return it to CPDHealth@herts.ac.uk to register on the modules you want to take.
