Amendments to UPR AS11 (Schedule of Awards) for 2019/20

This paper summarises the approved amendments to UPR AS11 for the 2019/20 academic year.

1. Doctor of Cyber Security (CSecD) and Doctor of Public Health (DPH)

Academic Board approved the introduction of these two Professional Doctorates in September 2018. However, the amendments to UPR AS11 incorrectly referred to the degree titles '*Doctorate in...*' rather than '*Doctor of...*' for the two awards. The following corrections to UPR AS11, section 3.4 have therefore been approved:

2. Award titles acknowledging employment experience

UPR AS11 currently states that award titles can recognise the successful completion of at least 36 weeks of placement activity, in the form of a sandwich award. This applies to all Bachelor's programmes, with and without Honours. Subsequent to this, the UH Placements Policy Group considered whether recognition could be given for approved placement learning which did not meet the 36 weeks threshold for sandwich. In response, in January 2019 ADC approved all University programmes to be able to offer award titles with the adjunct '(with Employment Experience)', on the understanding that (i) programme

specifications are amended to identify these award titles and (ii) they can only be awarded subject to successful completion and assessment of the activities concerned. The following amendment to UPR AS11, section 2.4 has therefore been approved:

2 REGULATIONS FOR AWARDS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HERTFORDSHIRE

2.4 Award titles acknowledging employment experience

2.4.1 Sandwich awards

A sandwich award requires the successful completion of at least **36** weeks full-time equivalent placement activity from a maximum of two separate *approved* placements, neither of which *shall* be normally less than **12** weeks in duration, in order for the award to be made. The sandwich award title should be:

2.4.2 Awards for employment experience

Successful completion of at least **12** weeks full-time equivalent placement activity (whether that be interrupted sandwich placement learning or alternative shorter periods of approved placement learning) from a maximum of two separate approved placements, neither of which shall be normally less than 4 weeks in duration, shall enable students to request the following award title:

3. Withdrawal of redundant awards

The University approved the awards of Enhanced Diploma and Enhanced Diploma in Midwifery to meet the needs of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC). However, both awards are now redundant, the last one having been awarded in February 2016. The School of HSK have confirmed that they no longer require these awards, and their withdrawal from the Schedule of awards has therefore been approved:
