If your name is different from the one that appears on your certificate, we will also ask you to present proof of name change (marriage certificate, deed poll certificate or similar).
GCSE English Language, Mathematics – grade 4 or above (Grade C or above under the old grading structure)	Original certificates, or Certified Statement of Results supplied by the original awarding body. Please note we do not accept transcripts, or statement of results from schools, or copies of certificates as evidence. If original certificates have been misplaced, you will need to request a certified statement of results here: https://www.gov.uk/replacement-exam-certificate	We ask that you submit scanned copies of your certificates as part of the recruitment process to ensure that you meet the academic entry requirements for the course. We will also ask you to present your original certificates when you first attend the University in September. If your name is different from the one that appears on your certificate, we will also ask you to present proof of name change (marriage certificate, deed poll or similar).
