About the course

The MSc in Cardiology and Stroke is a comprehensive clinical academic course designed and developed to suit the training needs of those with career intentions in cardiology, stroke, acute or emergency medicine and general practitioners wishing to develop a specialist interest. We also welcome applications from Cardiac and Stroke Specialist practitioners.

The course content:

Includes expert clinical assessment and the appropriate use of diagnostics such as:

- ECG
- Echo
- CT
- MRI

As well as modern management and new developments in both fields

Sample modules include:

- Applied Clinical Assessment and Investigation in Cardiology and Stroke
- Decision Making in Cardiology and Stroke
- Specialist Master classes in Cardiology e.g. Aortic valve disease, Angina, Atrial fibrillation
- Specialist Master classes in Stroke e.g. Hyperacute Stroke Management

Remote Delivery

Content will be delivered remotely so that the course can fit around a busy working life. Master classes will augment the basic modules to provide focus on sub-specialty areas. Where attendance is required it will be at the state of the art Clinical Simulation centre at the University of Hertfordshire with easy access from Central London.

Teaching Team

The teaching team is led by consultant specialists and a range of specialist clinicians will support the teaching and the participants. The course follows the JRCTPB stroke and cardiology specialist training curricula.

Awards

Awards include MSc in Cardiology and Stroke, with interim awards as postgraduate certificate and postgraduate diploma level. Modules can also be accessed as a short courses.
