Make sure you pick up your UH Wristband when you collect your key, or head to the Student Centre in the Hutton Hub to pick one up at any time - the wristband shows everyone you are a UH student, even if you haven't collected your ID card at your Registration session. It will give you access to the student discount on Uno Busses and get you onto the free Shuttle Bus between campuses.

Remember, this wristband will NOT get you access to the Freshers' events, the Freshers' Wristband needs to be purchased separately by visiting the Hertfordshire Students' Union website.
